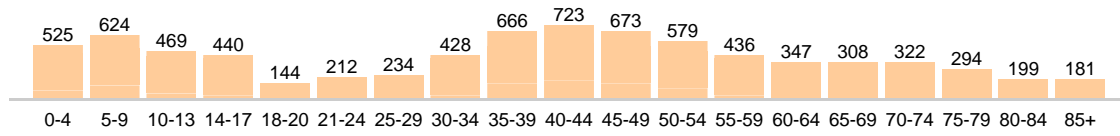

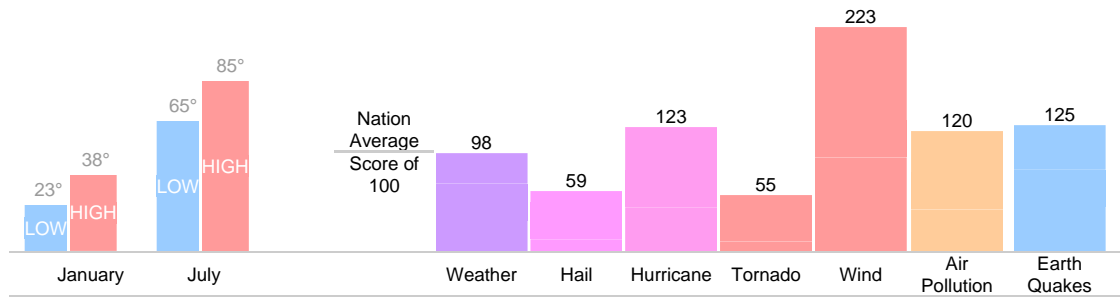
Age Demographic

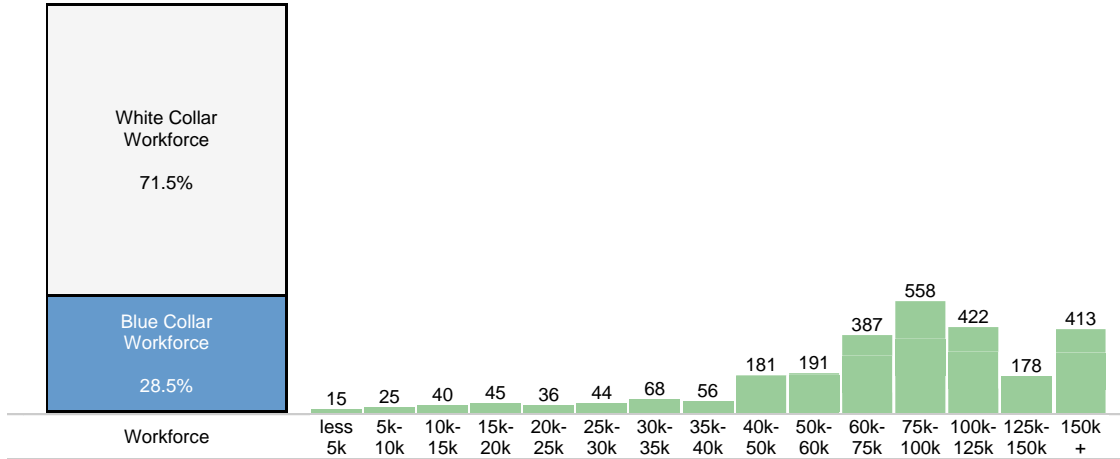

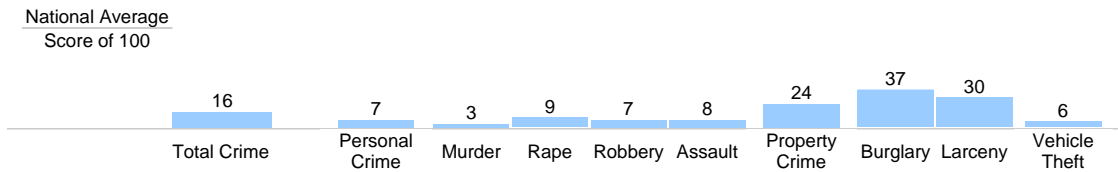
Wealth Breakdown
